The Tenors Ending Spring 2016 Leg of National Tour at The Hanover Theatre

Worcester, Mass. (March 8, 2016) *The Tenors* kicked off their North American Under One Sky tour back in October 2015. Now, several cities later, this Canadian, multi-platinum, JUNO Award winning vocal group is coming to The Hanover Theatre in downtown Worcester on Wednesday, March 16, 2016 at 7:30 p.m.

With several television specials, new music videos, a slate of high-profile appearances and performances in over 70 cities, *The Tenors* have been busy since the release of Under One Sky back in June 2015. Upon debuting at #1 on Billboard's Classical Crossover Chart and Classical Overall Charts respectively, *The Tenors* made stops at "The Today Show," "Fox News Edge," "Good Day New York," "SiriusXM," "Associated Press," Hallmark Channel's "Home & Family" and more. Under One Sky is certified gold in Canada and topped the charts when they achieved a #1 Classical Album and were on the Top Album Chart just behind Mumford & Sons and Josh Groban.

Under One Sky is a 13-track album combining a mix of originals alongside new interpretations of familiar favorites. The album spans anthems, classic covers and original songs penned and co-penned by *The Tenors* themselves. Check out their moving video of their inspiring cover of "[Lean On Me.](#)"

About The Hanover Theatre

The Hanover Theatre continues to draw over 170,000 patrons annually with world-class performances and headlining acts including Broadway hits (“Les Misérables,” “Jersey Boys,” “Camelot”); comedians (Dave Chappelle, Jay Leno, Daniel Tosh); musical acts (Neil Young, Aretha Franklin, John Legend); and everything in between (“A Christmas Carol,” Maya Angelou, Rudy Giuliani, Alvin Ailey American Dance Theatre). Consistently ranked by POLLSTAR as one of the Top Theatres in the World, the theatre opened in March of 2008 following a \$32 million historic renovation. Over the last seven seasons, the theatre has established its place as a world-class performing arts venue, acting as a catalyst for the economic development of downtown Worcester. In the spring of 2015, the theatre finalized the purchase of a vacant, three-floor former office building with street-level retail space at 551 Main Street. The building will ultimately house office space for theatre administration, function areas, a restaurant on the ground floor and a performing arts school on the lower level. The building will open in summer 2016.
