Repertory Report

The Hanover Theatre Repertory (THT Rep) enjoyed its **first full season of bringing professional plays to downtown Worcester** producing five projects: *Macbeth, The Poe Double Header,* experimental staged readings of *Judith* and *The Crucible,* and *The Marvelous Party.*

We **engaged more than 50 creative team members** across those projects, including Worc @ Play and teen conservatory students.

We had **five sold out student matinees** including *Macbeth* and *The Poe Double Header*.

We sold over 3,000 tickets to over 1,000 households.
