# Supporters Exceed \$1.5 Million Matching Grant Challenge for The Hanover Theatre Repertory!

**Worcester, Mass. (March 4, 2024)** Three cheers! <u>The Hanover Theatre Repertory</u> (<u>THT Rep</u>) has exceeded the \$1.5 Million McDonough Family Foundation matching grant challenge, raising \$1,583,823 over the course of 15 months.

The challenge was first announced in October 2022 ahead of a riveting performance of *Macbeth,* presented by THT Rep in the BrickBox Theater at the <u>Jean McDonough Arts Center</u> (JMAC).

The late Jean and Myles McDonough were active community leaders and steadfast supporters of the local arts scene. The venue at 20 Franklin St. was named the Jean McDonough Arts Center after Mrs. McDonough generously gifted \$2 million to the project.

"Our family is incredibly proud to have funded the Jean McDonough Arts Center, which serves as home to The BrickBox Theater," the McDonough family said. "It's only logical that we would now support THT Rep in its efforts to animate the BrickBox with professional plays."

Ending December 31, 2023, THT Rep received \$451,101 in donations from 295 individuals with gifts ranging from \$3 to \$125,00. Additional local foundations provided tremendous support:
